Application for Membership – Notes

1. Please forward your completed application form to the Club Office accompanied with a deposit of £50.00, which is non-returnable. When accepted into the Club this amount will be deducted from your Subscription.
2. On receipt, applications are displayed on the Club Notice Board for not less than 10 days.
3. When offered Membership you will be expected to take this up within 21 days.
4. The Joining Fee and Subscriptions payable will be those in force at the time you are admitted to Membership.

All Fees are due annually on the 1st February.

Membership Categories

Ordinary – Ordinary Membership shall be open to all adults.

Flexible - Shall be open to all adults. The flexible member will be awarded 200 points, which can be redeemed at the rate of 20 points per weekend round, and 10 points for a weekday round. A single top up purchase can be made each year, with a further payment of £50 giving a further 40 points. They shall have use of the Course and Clubhouse and will be permitted to play in Club competitions for purpose of Handicap maintenance only.

Dual – Dual Membership shall be open to all adults who have primary membership of another Golf Club. They shall have use of the Course and Clubhouse and will be permitted to play in Club competitions for the purpose of Handicap maintenance only.

Youth/Student – Youth/Student Membership shall be open to anyone between the age of 18 and 23. They shall have use of the Course and Clubhouse and will be permitted to play in Club Competitions as determined by the playing section of the Club.

Overseas – Overseas Membership shall be open to all persons residing out-with the United Kingdom. They shall have use of the Course and Clubhouse and will be permitted to play in Club competitions for purpose of Handicap maintenance only.

Junior – Junior Membership shall be open to all persons under the age of eighteen, at the discretion of the Council. Juniors shall have limited use of the Course and Clubhouse. Juniors will be permitted to play from yellow tees for purpose of handicap maintenance and competitive purposes in Junior Competitions. Boys on attaining a handicap of 18 or better will play from the White Medal tees in competitions.

Parent & Child – Parent & Child shall be open to all persons with a child aged under 18 years of age. The Adult shall have full use of the Clubhouse and will only be permitted to play with their child. The Child would be a full Junior Member and may play at anytime with or without their Parent.

Social – Social Membership shall be open to anyone over the age of 18 years. They shall be entitled to 36 holes of golf per year and full use of Clubhouse including Bar and Catering facilities.
